

The Greater London Combined Authority **Pathways to Employment, Education and Training Programme** provides tailored support for young people to move into Employment, Education and Training. Our support is offered through face-to-face and remote sessions.

Who is eligible?

Young Londoners aged 16 to 24 who are not in education, employment or training and:

- Live in Barking & Dagenham, Bexley, Bromley, Enfield, Greenwich, Havering, Newham, Redbridge, or Waltham Forest
- Looked after, or care leavers
- Homeless, at risk of being homeless, or fall into two or more of these categories; lone parent, a young carer, in debt, involved in criminal activity or substance misuse.

Exclusions:

- Asylum seekers or migrants who do not have permission to work, and are not in care
- Young people receiving support via the Work and Health Programme
- Under 18's in mainstream education, but currently excluded from school.

What does the programme offer?

Our services include:

- Building relationships with partners and external services via our Engagement Advisors to generate referrals
- Employment Coaches working with Engagement Advisors, to plus mental wellbeing support from health-qualified Key Workers, to support participant needs
- Access to short, funded certificated courses, as well as jobs, work placements, training, education and apprenticeships

- Intensive, personalised one-to-one remote support, with action plans
- Tailored interventions, such as employability, CV building and mock interview workshops
- Tracking progress, mood, and support needs by phone or text
- Access to user forums for feedback and ideas in improving our service.

Programme delivery and funding

MAXIMUS UK is delivering this European Social Fund programme until June 2023, on behalf of the Greater London Combined Authority.

Our delivery is via the Local London boroughs, this partnership is responsible for commissioning the UK Government's Work and Health Programme in East and South East London.

Participants will be supported remotely, and until EET targets are reached for 26 out of 32 weeks. As Government guidance on social distancing changes and we feel that it is safe to do so, we will resume face-to-face support.
